<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ How well did the speaker analyze and prepare for this particular audience?</li> <li>▪ Did the speaker deliver a speech that was appropriate for the occasion?</li> <li>▪ Did it conform to the assignment – <i>time limit</i>, type of speech?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Was the topic appropriate for the audience?</li> <li>▪ Did it have a clear thesis?</li> <li>▪ Were there clear sub-points?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Was the speech well-organized and easy to follow?</li> <li>▪ Did it have identifiable parts?</li> <li>▪ Was there support?</li> <li>▪ Were there transitions?</li> <li>▪ Are all the attendant papers turned in?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ How well did the speaker use language?</li> <li>▪ Visuals or media?</li> <li>▪ Nonverbal cues?</li> <li>▪ Did the delivery add to or detract from the impact of the message?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Did the speaker establish credibility?</li> <li>▪ Was the topic sensitive to the culture of the situation?</li> </ul>
