



CHURCH MATCH GRANT

Pillar College invites churches to help their congregants secure the resources needed to finance their education at a Christian College. In this way, Pillar College and the local church can work as partners in preparing today's student to be Christian leaders.

The Church Match Grant is NEED-BASED aid. In order to apply, students must meet the following three criteria:

1. Receive funds from a church.
2. Maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA.
3. Be enrolled in 6 or more credits in the semester of application.
 - a. Students enrolled for 6-11 credit hours in a semester are eligible for a \$250 match
 - b. Students enrolled in 12 or more credit hours in a semester are eligible for a \$500 match

Please follow the succeeding procedure to apply for this grant for the current semester:

1. Student signs this form stating that they meet the above listed criteria.
2. The church completes this form.
3. Church submits a check payable to Pillar College and mails check and form to the address listed above by the beginning of the semester.
4. Returning students must also submit supporting documentation of meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Pillar College Grants are applied only if tuition costs plus semester fees are not covered by NJ TAG, Pell grants or other outside agencies. If you are eligible for Pillar College Grants, the maximum that may be awarded during the first semester is \$2000.00 and then \$1500.00 per semester after that.

Pillar College Tuition Grant forms are due in the Financial Aid Office by the start of your first class in the new semester.
