



## HOME SCHOOL GRANT

The Pillar College Home School Grant is awarded to fulltime matriculated students who were home schooled a minimum of two years of their high school education. A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required for award renewal. Award amount is up to \$500 per semester or \$1,000 annually.

Supporting documentation (including proof of Satisfactory Academic Progress for returning students) must accompany this application form to be submitted to the Financial Aid Office by the start of each new semester.

Pillar College Grants are applied only if tuition costs plus semester fees are not covered by NJ TAG, Pell grants or other outside agencies. If you are eligible for Pillar College grants, the maximum that may be awarded during the first semester is \$2000.00 and then \$1500.00 per semester after that.

Pillar College Tuition Grant forms are due in the Financial Aid Office by the start of your first class in the new semester.
