The Elementary Education program is unique in that while most Bachelor programs requires a minimum of 120 credits and a 2.0 cumulative GPA, the New Jersey Department of Education requires additional coursework, a 3.0 cumulative GPA, AND a minimum of 3.0 in your major and all education courses in order to be certified. Literacy and Intercultural Communications courses accompanying EDUC coursework to assist students in meeting English Language Arts and diversity requirements for classroom instruction. Together, students complete 123 credits. A grade of B- or better in each professional education course is required plus an Education GPA of AT LEAST 3.0, and an overall GPA of 3.0.

**NOTE: All students seeking licensure as part of this educator preparation program must meet all basic skills requirements for teacher preparation and teacher certification as adopted by the State Board of Education on June 4, 2014. Students who do not meet the basic skills requirements as outlined in this program may be eligible to complete course concentrations listed below without seeking licensure.**
